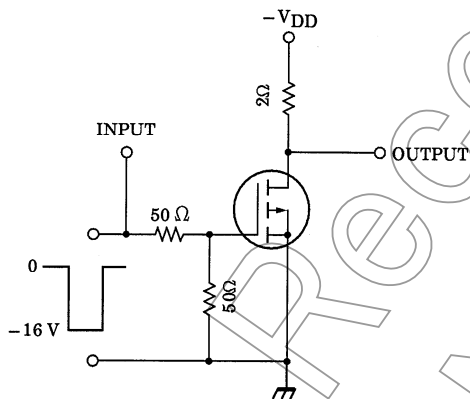

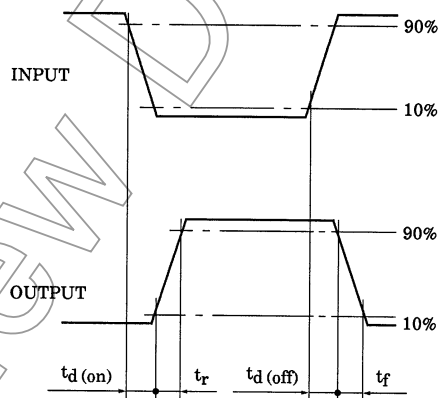




Switching Time Test Circuit
