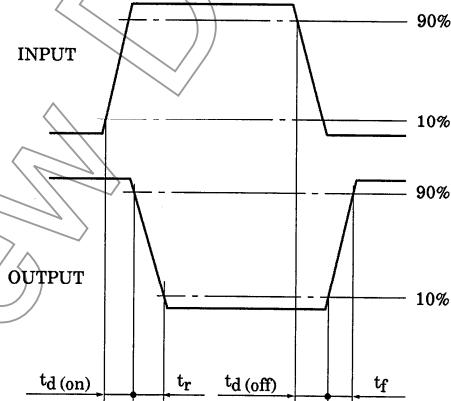




Switching Time Test Circuit
