Low voltage CMOS 16-bit bus buffer (3-state)
with 5V tolerant inputs and outputs

Features

- 5V tolerant inputs and outputs
- High speed:

Description

The 74LCX16240 is a low voltage CMOS 16 BIT BUS BUFFER fabricated with sub-micron silicon gate and double-layer metal wiring C²MOS technology. It is ideal for low power and high speed 3.3V applications; it can be interfaced to 5V signal environment for both inputs and outputs.

Any nG output control governs four BUS BUFFERS. Output Enable input (nG) tied together gives full 16-bit operation.

When nG is LOW, the outputs are on. When nG is HIGH, the output are in high impedance state.

This device is designed to be used with 3 state memory address drivers, etc.

It has same speed performance at 3.3V than 5V AC/ACT family, combined with a lower power consumption.

All inputs and outputs are equipped with protection circuits against static discharge, giving them 2KV ESD immunity and transient excess voltage.

Figure 1. IEC logic symbols

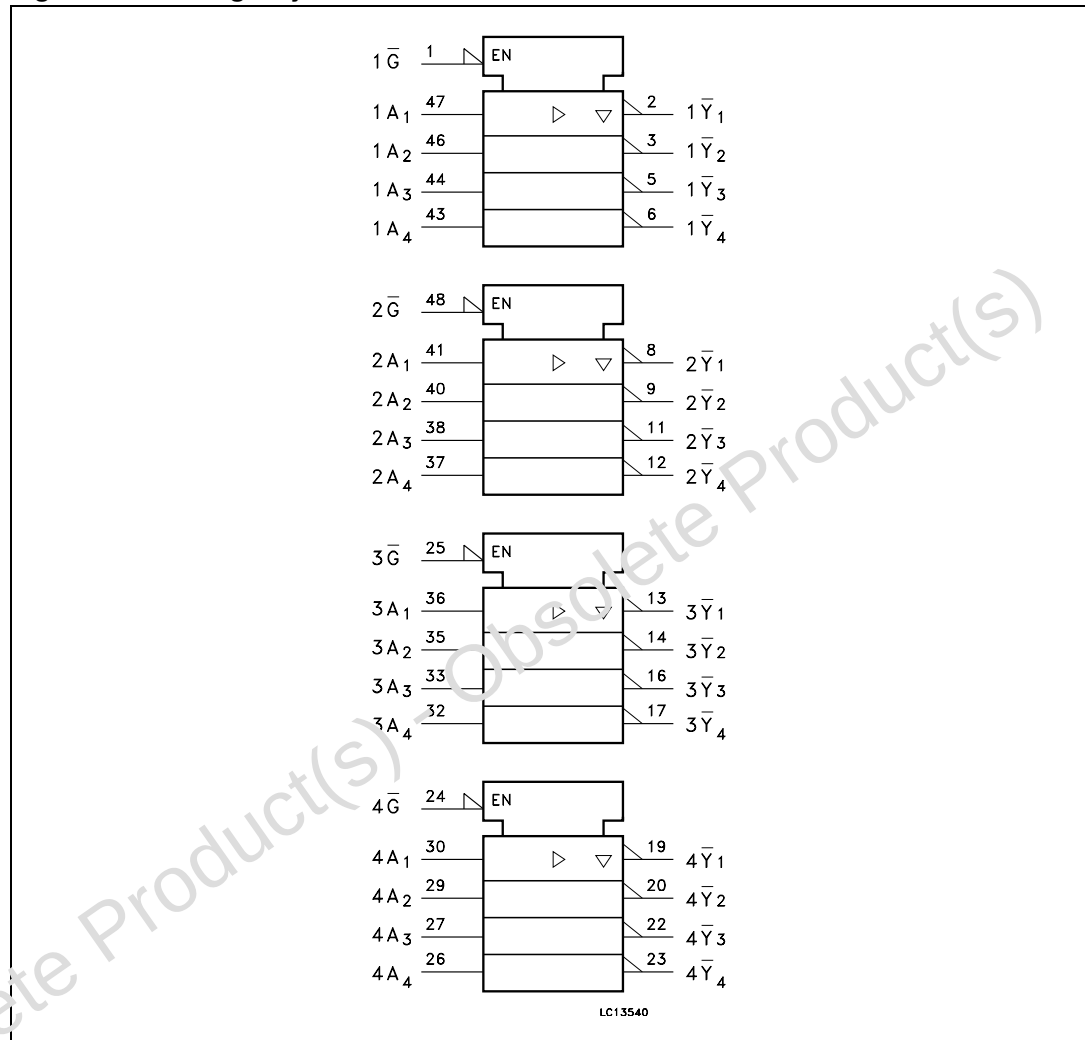
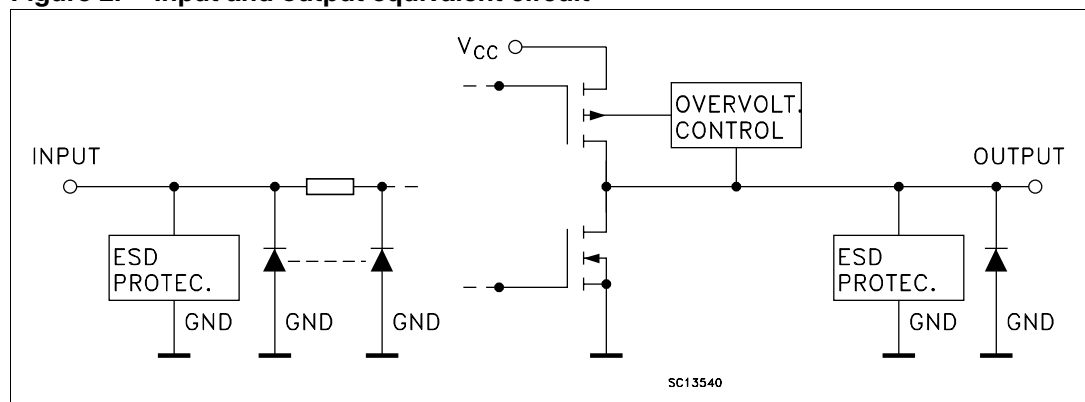


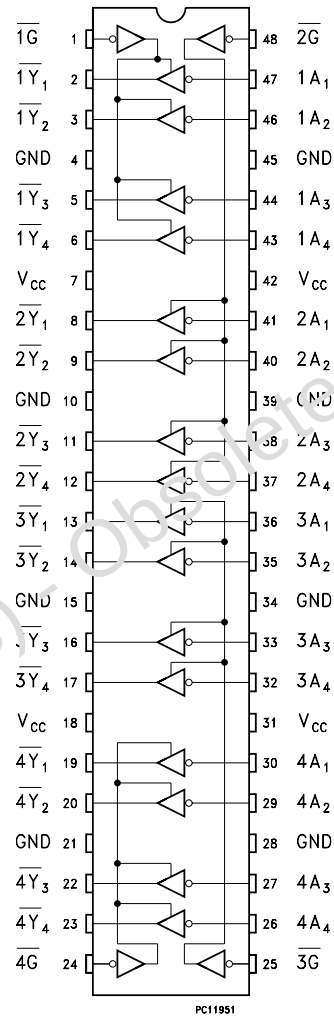
Figure 2. Input and output equivalent circuit

Figure 4. Test circuit

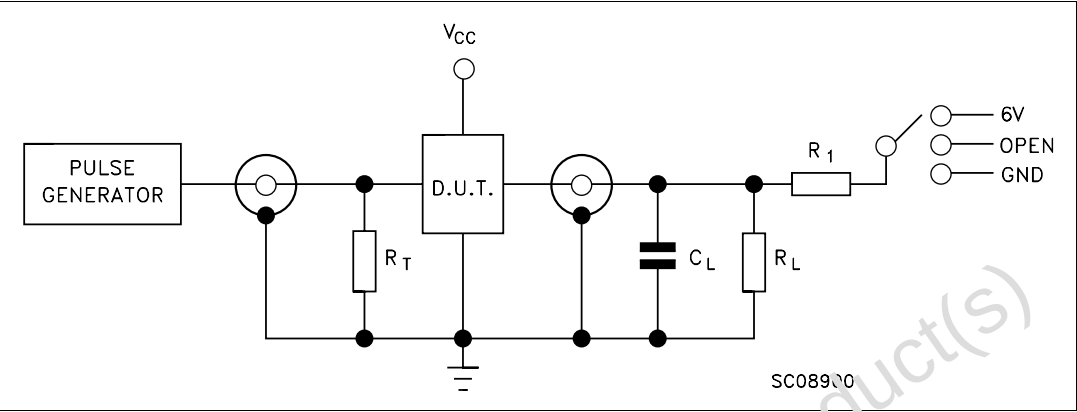


Figure 5. Test circuit

Figure 6. Propagation delays ($f = 1\text{MHz}$; 50% duty cycle)

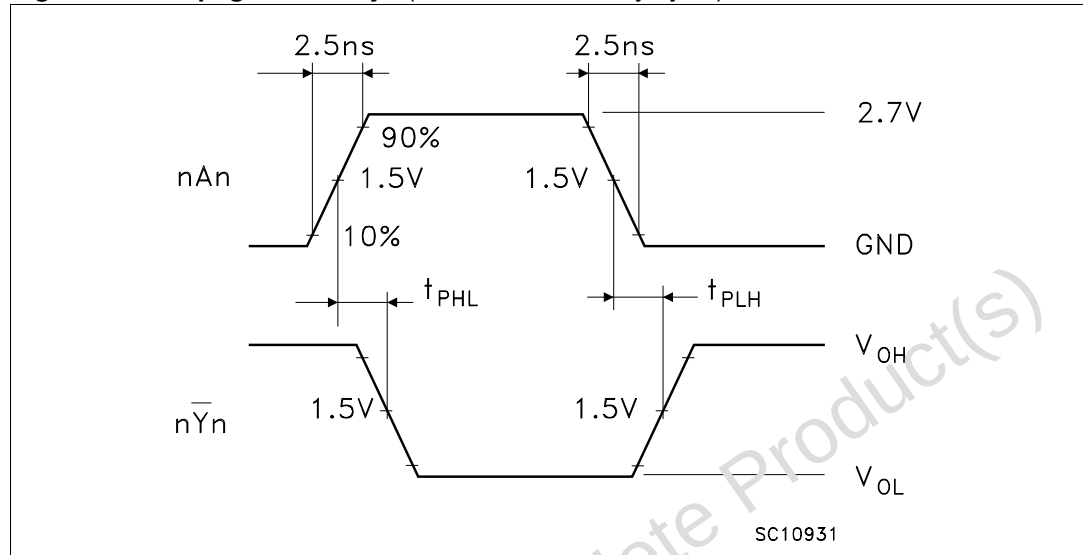
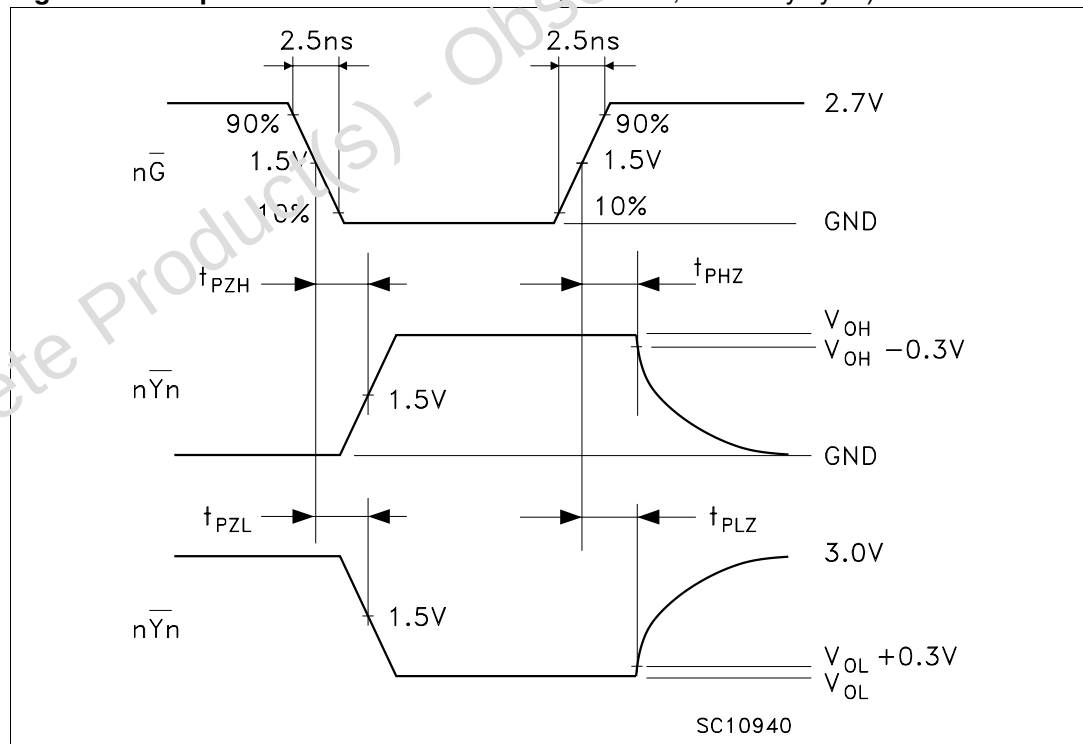


Figure 7. Output enable and disable time ($f = 1\text{MHz}$; 50% duty cycle)

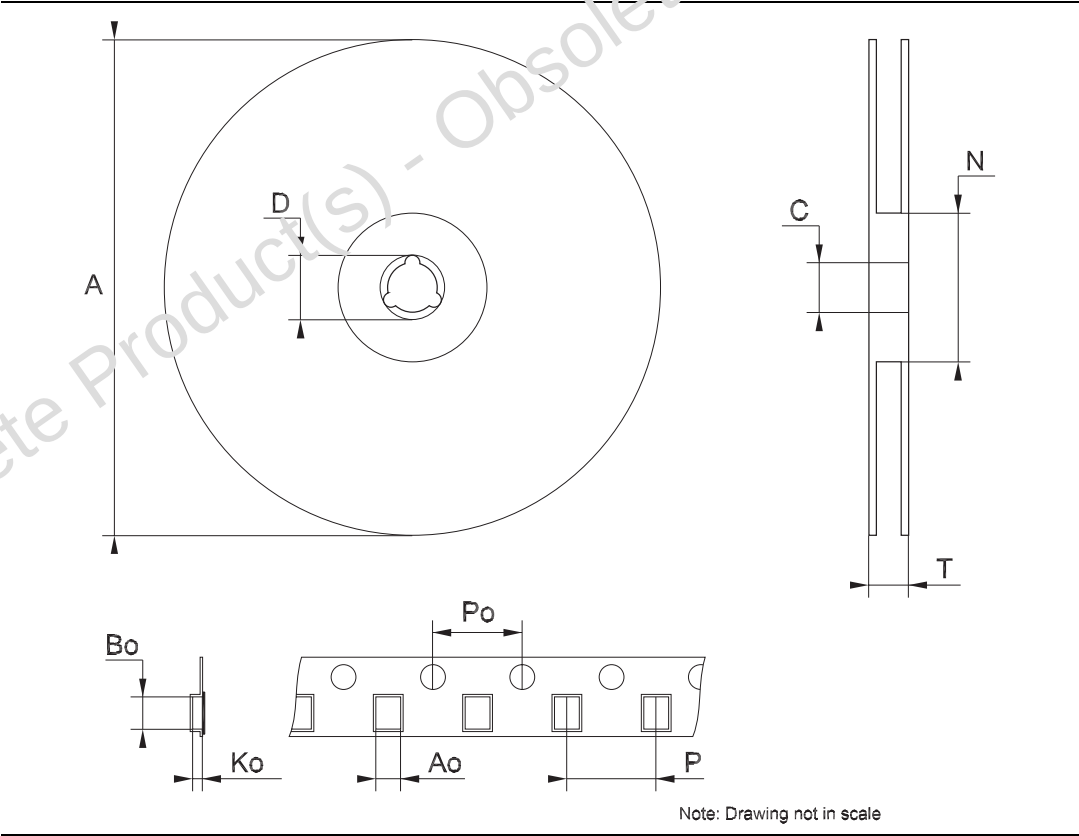
